English	<p>Writing</p> <p>Research an endangered animal and write a persuasive letter to the government with a list of reasons how they/we can help.</p>	<p>Reading</p> <p>Read an article of a local environmental issue. You may present your findings to the class.</p>
Maths and Science	<p>Maths</p> <p>Look for statistics on the environment. This could be used to aid your writing and may be about recycling, deforestation, endangered species or littering.</p>	<p>Science</p> <p>Take a look at The Regenerators website. Choose a topic and create a presentation about it. You can present your learning in any way you like. The Regenerators - Lessons age 7 to 11 - BBC Bitesize</p>
Being creative	<p>Plan and make a 'Green Lunch Box'</p> <p>How can you make a lunchbox with no single use plastic?</p>	<p>Drawing/3D Art</p> <p>Draw an endangered animal or create a 3D sculpture of one. You may choose to use recycled materials for this! If you're interested in computing, you could do this online using 'Polypad'</p>
Finding out	<p>Islam</p> <p>Look into the local Muslim community and see how Islam is celebrated. Make a fact-file of the things you have found out. Can you challenge yourself by making comparisons with other religions?</p>	<p>Recycling in the community</p> <p>How can you help our local community stay tidy? Could you join a litter picking group? You could link this with your maths learning and count the litter you find in Ashford. Keep Ashford Clean - CleanupUK</p>
